



## Public Involvement Schedule and Topics

The Clackamas Regional Center (CRC) Connections Project public involvement program includes a series of Stakeholder Working Group (SWG) and Technical Working Group (TWG) meetings and two major public outreach points. The timeline below shows the anticipated schedule for working group and public meetings, as well as key topics for discussion at each meeting. *(Note: schedule and order of discussion topics is subject to change. Groups will meet separately unless noted otherwise.)*
